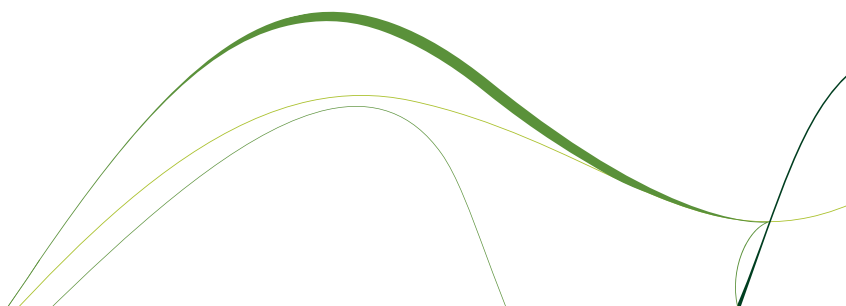

<p>New Irish RTC Scheme</p>	<p>In January 2012, the Irish RCT scheme will change to include a new tax rate of 20% in addition to the existing rate of 35%. New fields on the HMRC/RCT tab (within Accounts parameters) have been introduced to allow the entry of the new tax rate. Within S/C Data, a new CIS type "R" has been added to represent the reduced tax rate. The calculation of tax on a purchase document will be based on these two fields being changed accordingly.</p>	<p>Compliance with the new RCT tax scheme being introduced by the Revenue from January 2012.</p>
